The conference focuses on the development crisis that has made the Islamic world as a world value blown by civilization transformations for local reasons that put it under regional, ethnic, institutional, and sectarian biases, and how it has transformed in the religious, political, and civilizational concept into a complex crisis, in which educational, humanitarian, security and societal bases will be disrupted. And since the civilization concept is a collective concept and has different characteristics that may be converging or conflicting. We in this joint international conference seek to approach scientific and methodological visions in a way that would develop the concept of civilization, its knowledge and development, and define the necessary foundational processes for emission from the entrance to the cultural specificity and local peculiarities.

The twelfth theme: Theology

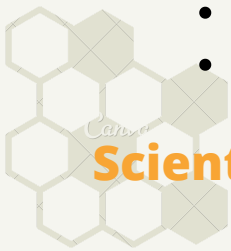

Terms of Publication

First: Formal Methodological Procedures

- The first paper of the study includes its title, full name, Scientific degree and place of work in Arabic and English and the e-mail.

- Determining research problems, main problem, its hypotheses, approaches, purpose, importance and previous studies in the form of statements included in the introduction and not based on the teaching method used in master theses and doctoral dissertations , the main concepts and their genealogies, research mechanisms, description and analysis, cumulative and partial conclusions and total results. A list of references according to their division into : references that have sacred considerations, such as religious, historical and fundamental books. Also modern and contemporary sources, and then the translated, ones as well as the sources in their foreign languages.

Terms of Publication

An abstract of the study is written within the limits of 150 words in volume 12 in the language of the article and in the English language as well as the key words that are appended to the abstract, and the Arabic abstract is arranged first, then the translated one secondly.

- The paper should include the research title, the name of the researcher or researchers, the abstract, the key words, the introduction, results, body, notes, and references.
- Two abstracts should be written, one in Arabic and another in English.
- The key words are written in Arabic after the abstract in Arabic, and key words in English after the abstract in English.
- The notes should be reduced to minimum on the research pages and should be indicated by star symbols.
- The research is printed using word programme according to the form in the publishing instructions, and no response will be given to papers submitted in Pdf.
- The pages of the paper should be within 20 – 30 pages printed using WORD with Traditional Arabic Font Type and 14 font size and singular without line spaces or enlargement.
- The researcher should follow APA (American Psychological Association) style in documentation, i.e. the paper should draw on sufficient scientific sources, previous studies, recommendations, suggestions and quotes.
- Titles and subtitles should be written in 14 font size for the paragraphs with enlargement.
- Notes are 4 cm in size on the four page directions (2 by 2 on both sides).
- Diagrams and illustrations are included in the essay, their titles and explanatory notes are written below.
- Tables are numbered sequentially, with their titles written above and explanatory notes below.
- The researcher must adhere to the documentation process and appreciate the efforts of others by pointing to the source of information for the importance of that in accepting his/her research through sound results based on sound ethical and research values.

Terms of Publication

- The researcher is committed to the specified sending date, and the research submitted after the deadline will not be responded, nor the research papers that do not adhere to the specified number and the methodology used.
- No researcher has the right after sending the notification of receiving the research to publish his/her paper except after the International Conference Committee announces its apology for publishing.
- The author must abide by the arbitration decisions and the required corrections within a period not exceeding (5) days.

Second: The Method of Documentation

Arabic sources are referred to in the text and they should include (the researcher's name or the nickname or last name of the author / the authors and the year of publication) and placed in parentheses, for example (Sayef al-Deen Abdul Fattah , The Concept ofRenewing, 1995, p. 22).

- In the case of a joint paper, the following procedure will be used: (Al-Hashemi, Al-Amin, 2019, p. 22)
- If there are more than three authors, the following procedure will be used: (Al-Hashemi et al., 2019, p. 22)

If the source is electronic, the following procedure will be used (the author) writes: the title of the article, the year and the site like this: (Al-Hashemi, The Methodological Crisis) 03/12/2019.

- The researcher should adhere to the documentation convention followed in Tawazun journal published on the website of the Al-Isbah Center for Education, civilization and strategic studies at the following link: <https://WWW.AL-ISBAAHCENTER.COM>

Terms of Publication

- The researcher must adhere to the basics of punctuation, the comma and the period sticks to the word without separation between them.
 - There must be a distinction between writing the comma in Latin (,) and Arabic (,).
- The conjunction "and" adheres to the word directly without separating. The text should be sent as it is without colour, bold fonts, glyphs, or squares and other shapes.
- The references at the end of the paper are numbered with numerical numbering (1, 2, 3, 4) and that the numbering for the references or the list of sources should be arranged alphabetically.
- The order starts with the title followed by the translated title, then the researcher's name and academic rank, followed by the translated name and his scientific rank.
- The term abstract and introduction must be written in this way (the abstract, the introduction) and not (abstract, introduction) and this applies to the English translation.
 - When dividing the sections of the study in the presentation and discussion, the research sections or its titles must be divided into (first, second, third ...) and not by following the approved school method that divides the study into sections and demands. Also the division does not approve the method based on numeric numbering (1, 2 ...).
- Linking paragraphs in the context of the idea and not separating them or increasing them, except when necessary.
- Set the direction of writing in the text and the margins for Arabic from the right, and for the Latin alphabet from the left.
 - The members of the Scientific Committee have the right to ask the researcher to delete and reformulate his research, or any part of it to suit the methodology of the conference.

Terms of Publication

The conference does not bear any responsibility for the opinions and researches received and it does not express its policy, nor is it responsible for any plagiarism after diligence, research and arbitration.

Third: Research Procedures

- The author must follow the recognized scientific principles in preparing and writing research papers in relation to referring information to its sources, documenting the quote and scientific trust.
- The article must be free from spelling, grammatical, linguistic and typographical errors as much as possible with the need to distinguish between Hamzatul Qata and Hamzatul Wasl.
- The field studies should adhere to the known methodology in presenting the problem, methodological steps, objectivity and validation, and in what regards the curriculum, sample, study tools, statistical methods, presenting and discussing the results.
- Researchers are committed to the required modifications decided by the relevant academic committee.
- The department concerned with the study decides to publish the material, sends the text to the editing and proofreading department, and takes its position in the proofreading according to the chronological order, then the paper is published according to the rules.

General Notes

The abstracts shall be answered in three days after the date of receiving the receipt.

- The researches shall be answered in ten days after the date of receiving the receipt.
- The researches shall be published in a special book and within specified numbers of conferences (free of charge). Collective researches are accepted.
